MINUTES
WFRC || Active Transportation Committee
August 11, 2026

WFRC Active Transportation Committee Meeting was held at the WFRC offices and via Zoom.

1. Introductions and consent agenda [00:00:36]

Draper City Mayor, Troy Walker, Chair for the Active Transportation Committee (ATC), welcomed members and guests to the meeting. Roll was taken for all attendees both around the room and online. **ACTION: [00:05:03]** Mayor Walker requested a motion to approve the [minutes](#) from the June 9, 2026, meeting. Jaron Robertson, UTA made the motion, and Holly Pearson, Salt Lake County, seconded. With no further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

2. Chair Report [00:05:50]

Mayor Walker shared that coordination with the Utah delegation and various transportation partners remains ongoing to champion diverse transit options. He highlighted that the state continues to advance the Utah Trail Network, supported by \$45 million in annual appropriations. Additionally, Mayor Walker observed that the federal administration has maintained its focus on vehicular infrastructure, such as roads and bridges, which has restricted the level of federal assistance available for active transportation initiatives.

3. Public comment [00:09:26]

No comments from the public were received. Committee members highlighted the utility of local shuttle services in facilitating access to various regional active transportation trails. Commissioner Blaine Fackrell, Committee Member, voiced a desire to see bicycle facilities constructed on Highway 66 in Morgan County within the next 5-10 years.

4. Perry City Presentation [00:16:13]

Bob Barnhill, Perry City, provided an overview of the recently finished segment of the Historic Orchard Parkway and the debut of a new downhill mountain bike facility. He detailed the various obstacles encountered during development and conveyed the local enthusiasm surrounding these latest active transportation projects.

5. When does your project need to be built? RTP Phasing Input [00:32:02]

Hugh Van Wagenen provided an overview of the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) timeline and facilitated a group discussion regarding essential projects and their appropriate phasing within the ongoing planning efforts.

6. Planning Connections to the Wasatch Front: UDOT Long-Range Plan [01:02:56]

Zane Pulver with UDOT delivered a presentation regarding the long-range planning efforts for Tooele and Morgan Counties, emphasizing the coordination between these initiatives and the WFRC planning framework. He clarified the current status of the development cycle and described how the finished UDOT long-range plan will be integrated with the WFRC Regional Transportation Plan upon their mutual completion, along with other state-wide transportation agencies, that will result in Utah's Unified Transportation Plan.

7. Overview of WFRC Funding Programs [01:13:41]

Ben Wuthrich and Byron Head, WFRC, provided a summary of the various funding opportunities administered by WFRC for local communities. Their presentation outlined the cyclical schedule for these programs, including critical application windows and the diverse types of projects eligible for financial support under each framework.

8. Other Business and Adjournment [01:27:04]

Mayor Walker shared details regarding the upcoming Get to the River Festival, inviting folks to attend the event. He also mentioned that the next ATC meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, October 13.

A motion to adjourn was made by Layton City Mayor, Joy Petro. The meeting was adjourned at 10:47 AM.
