1. SR-36/ I-80 Project Update

Becky Stromness with UDOT provided an update regarding the SR-36 NB and I-80 EB widening projects. Pouring the concrete on I-80 for the EB auxiliary lane is expected to last another 9-10 days. An initial layer of asphalt is being laid for the additional SR-36 NB lane. Both projects will have minimal work done over the winter and resume in the spring with the anticipation of projects being completed summer 2026.

2. Lake Point City Transportation Plan

Josh Gibbons and Joseph Browning with Hales Engineering gave an overview of the recently completed Lake Point City Transportation Plan. Josh reviewed how the Plan was developed and identified several roadway projects included in the Plan, such as frontage roads along SR-36. They also briefly discussed the need for transit and active transportation connectivity.

3. Tooele City Transportation Plan

Paul Hansen with Tooele City reviewed the existing Tooele City Transportation Plan. He discussed the corridor agreements with UDOT that are in place for SR-36 and SR-112 and existing and future signalized intersections. Paul noted that the City is in the very early stages of updating this Plan, and that the Active Transportation Plan that the City adopted two years ago will be incorporated into this update.

4. Utah Trail Network Status

Wayne Bennion with WFRC reported that he wanted to make sure everyone was aware that UDOT released a draft master plan for the Utah Trail Network (UTN) at the annual Utah Transportation Conference. UDOT held two webinars in November to obtain input from local governments and stakeholders, and they also provided a survey option for those unable to attend the webinars. Wayne briefly reviewed the facilities and facility types identified in Tooele Valley. More information is available at <https://utahtrailnetwork.udot.utah.gov/>. Geoff Dupaix with UDOT noted that the UTN team is looking for input to assist the UTN team to identify priorities.

5. Other Business

Kim Clausing with North Tooele Fire District reported that they received a Utah Outdoor Recreation Grant that has allowed them to better respond to emergency situations in recreation areas.

Wayne Bennion provided reminders of the following upcoming funding-related deadlines:

- Tooele Valley CMAQ - Letters of intent due December 15, 2025
- Funding administered through UDOT and Joint Highway Committee - Applications due January 9, 2026
- Transportation Alternatives Program funding through UDOT Region 2 - Applications due January 13, 2026
